Before 45 credits, students must complete their fundamental studies, 3 courses in distributive studies, and JOUR201 with a grade of C- or better. They also must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0. This is the first of two benchmarks.

B 75-credit review is a performance review during the junior year to ensure students fulfill their editing and news writing requirements. Students must complete JOUR 202 or 262 and JOUR 320 or 360 before 75 credits. This is the second of two benchmarks.
